



2023 Rosé

Dry and lively, with fresh citrus acidity reminiscent of blood orange and grapefruit. Subtle herbal notes complement the ripe strawberry, cranberry, rhubarb and red currant flavours. The result is beautifully complex and balanced.

VINTAGE

A challenging vintage for much of the Okanagan Valley as winter damage had a devastating effect. Thankfully, aside from a decrease in our Syrah and Chardonnay, it was relatively average yield at Painted Rock. Spring sprang a little late with a slightly delayed bud burst but things caught up nicely by mid-June. Warm, dry weather with short bursts of rain led to vigorous growth and a wonderful fruit set. The consistently warm and dry summer has lead to our earliest ever harvest starting September 8th.

WINEMAKING

Our deliciously nuanced rosé is made from 100% estate grown fruit, predominately using the saignée method with all the red bordeaux varietals from our single vineyard site.
